As we know, the ISIS terrorist organization has been a major problem for the countries of the world since 1999. This group, which is mainly active in Iraq and Syria, has camps for 70 thousand people in these regions where their families stay. Unfortunately, the living conditions of the women and children in these camps are not very encouraging, but nobody hears the people's cries for help. Those who leave the camps of ISIS, which are still carrying out active attacks in many countries, are also returning to their own countries. Although each country has a different policy, most countries around the world still keep people from the camps in prison on the grounds that they may have connections with ISIS.

A total of 54 people came out of the camp, where 162 thousand 498 people lived, and there are attempts to escape every day. Many of these fleeing people also plan to cross Greece to return to their country. In addition, ISIS members who were deported by Turkey also want to enter our country. So far, we have determined that 1 person has entered our country as a member of ISIS. And this intruder appears to be one of the most active members of ISIS. Our police caught this person as quickly as possible. As the Minister of Justice Nikos Dendias mentioned after this incident, we are inclined to increase the punishment for all kinds of terrorist crimes. We would like to make it public that we have no affiliation with ISIS since 2020, and that we do not support any of its movements.

As the Greek government, we think that we can provide potential assistance such as As the Greek government, we think that we can provide potential assistance such as keeping people who are trying to return to their own country in our country at a high level of security for a while by opening certain camps, and providing hygienic and food assistance to babies and children who need help in the camps.

We would also like to imply that there are many activities that can be done as UN. Most of the people there are innocent. The women's wives are kept there because they are ISIS members, and the children are just unlucky. Ambassadors can be sent to women and girls for hygiene, hairdressing, clothing and food. Or the innocent people in Al-Hawl can be taken and taken to a separate camp set up by the UN. We believe that more countries can be interacted with and more solutions can be found.
