Especially in recent years, as China's pressure on Uyghur Turks has increased, Ukraine's stance on this issue has become more pronounced.

Universal Declaration Of Human Rights Article 5: "No one shall be subjected to torture or to cruel, inhuman or degrading treatment or punishment."

Uyghur Turks have been subjected to Chinese persecution since the 1960s, but nowadays they are facing the greatest persecution in the modern sense. In the modern sense, the Chinese government's repression of Uyghur Turks The Chinese government has begun to take harsh measures against Uyghur Turks living in East Xinjiang under the pretext of "fighting terrorism". These measures include mass detentions, arbitrary arrests and concentration camps. The Chinese government has tried to prevent Uyghur Turks from preserving their religion and culture by destroying mosques, banning the Uyghur language, and preventing Muslims from religious events such as Ramadan.

Ukraine does not have a clear policy or official position on the Uyghur Turks, but we are very sensitive to human rights and the rights of ethnic groups and we want to discuss this issue not only in Ukraine but also with all countries of the world to find a solution.

And what will happen to the Uyghur Turks? As with every nation, we will do our best to ensure that the freedom of life of Uyghur Turks is not restricted.
