

Position Paper

A founding member and the host State of UNESCO, France prioritizes education, culture, science, information and communication in its domestic and international policies. As a member of the Executive Board, France has committed to the success of UNESCO and its overarching priorities. As a candidate of the UNESCO Executive Board for the 2023-2027 term, France wishes to continue its commitment to the Organization, its normative work and its work on the ground.

Natural disasters have caused billions of losses since the 80s, and by 2022 this figure has reached. 10 billions euro.

In the years when severe hailstorms, floods and hurricanes occurred, France did not experience drought problems. In the regions where these disasters occurred, houses were evacuated by the order of the president

The gradual disappearance of valuable items in evacuated houses has become a problem for the people around. Most theft is observed here. Unfortunately, this scenario happens far too frequently in France - with an average of 596 burglaries taking place every day. A total of 217,600 burglaries were reported in 2023 according to figures released by the French Interior Ministry in January 2024.
