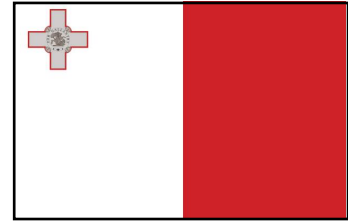


## **POSITION PAPER**

**Topic: Israel-Palestine Conflict**



Malta is an archipelago which has been a host location for many religions and ethnic groups. According to UHDR (The Universal Declaration of Human Rights), Malta is one of the most improver countries in the world.

As we indicated at our last UNSC statement, the war between Hamas and Israel has evolved into an intent to deprive civilians in Gaza. Palestinians catastrophic lack of food and water is the main outcome of Israel military. Israel has overstepped by causing food, water, fuel insecurities and prohibiting to receive helps from UNRWA (The United Nations Relief and Works Agency for Palestine Refugees in the Near East). Nearly 600.000 Palestinians are suffering from famine just because they can't get out of the area due to Israels blockade.

Regarding of the facts that: respiratory diseases -which is considered one of the three main reasons of death by WHO (World Health Organization)- and poses a threat to all kinds of species as consequences of acid rains and forcing people in Gaza to breathe in the toxic air into their lungs; one hospital uses at least 22.710 liters of fuel in one day however, Gaza has a source of 20.000 liters of fuel in a day and sometimes less than it. Education is an important problem at the area too. Almost none of the children can have any kinds of education until the war lasts or moving them far away from the war.

For giving sustainable and effective solutions to these main issues, we have to focus on especially civils healthcare and education. All the reasons above are why we have been defending that some of the best solutions are reopening the Port Ashdod to minister aid to a certain level or a permanent ceasefire.
