Pakistan's population is approximately 255 million and it is fourth in Asia. Pakistan's area is approximately 770,800 km<sup>2</sup>. The GDP is approximately 385 billion dollars and it is now 41st in the world rankings. GDP per capita is also 1644 dollars. According to Microsoft's 2025 technical report the average Artificial Intelligence usage rate in Pakistan is 33%.
