Some of these policies

Fee and compulsory education

Gender equality in education

Mexico has taken special measures to ensure girls' education. It has also carried out various projects to empower girls in education and eliminate abuses such as early marriage and child labor.

These Mexican projects improved education and it aims to ensure that disadvantaged groups within the country receive better education or access educational opportunities and to reduce educational discrimination.
