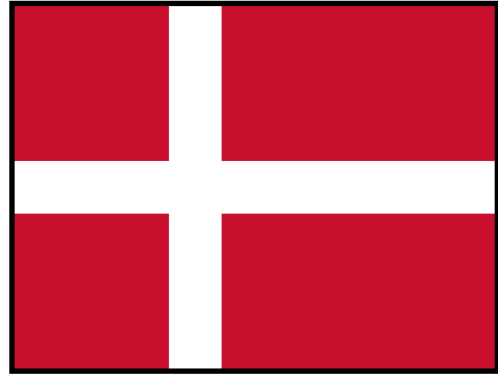


Country: Kingdom of Denmark
