Paragraph 1 - Country Background

Paragraph 2 - Historical Background & International Actions

Classical colonialism began in the 15th century and ended in the 19th century, but it still continues in some places called neocolonialism is not done directly militarily, but economically and indirectly. To handle colonization topic, UN established "International Decade for the Eradication of Colonialism" from 1990 to 2000. When the UN was founded, 750 million people lived under colonial rule. Since 1945, over 80 former colonies have gained independence, thanks in part to the work of the Specpol. Today, fewer than two million people live in 17 Non-Self-Governing territories, and SPECPOL holds hearings with civil society organizations and private individuals, from these areas. SPECPOL also covers issues related to the Middle East, Palestinian refugees, and Israeli practices, as well as topics like the effects of atomic radiation, peacekeeping operations, space exploration, and international cooperation for peaceful uses of outer space.
