Statement of National Goals for the National Press

The United Kingdom is attending a NATO summit at a time when European security is under threat. This meeting must be conducted with responsibility and credibility; NATO must prove that it is united, strong and stable.

The UK's purpose for joining is clear: peace should not be delayed or risked; when security is threatened, NATO must proceed with purpose and discipline; the United Kingdom believes that unity is necessary to prevent further instability.

Our goals at this summit are clear: firstly, we want a NATO position that supports peace and protects civilians; secondly, responsibilities must be shared equally; and thirdly, we must remain an alliance that stands by NATO decisions.

We expect this summit to have clear results. Strong alliances depend on clear commitments. The United Kingdom supports the continuation of military readiness while acting with political control and responsibility.

The United Kingdom is coming fully prepared. Our government has been in contact with allies and has carefully assessed the situation. The UK is ready to demonstrate its experience and leadership and to contribute.

The UK believes that responsibility, stability, and resolve are built on NATO values and faith in its objectives. The United Kingdom is ready to overcome this situation
