The Indo-Pacific has been emerging for decades firstly through its population, secondly its economy and currently due to its military and geopolitical ambitions. The concept of Indo-Pacific, born in the early 2000s, refers to commonality in interests and issues between the two oceans and their associated countries. Of all the regions of our globe, the Indo-Pacific region is the most populated and has the potential to become the world's richest and most developed area in the next 20 years. NATO's new Strategic Concept has highlighted the importance of the Indo-Pacific for Allied security and approved the growing collaboration with like-minded partners in the region.
