In addition, cannabis distribution places that the state allows for sale are frequently monitored and managed. In addition, penalties for causing public nuisance from the recreational use of cannabis still apply. Offenders may have to serve jail terms or responsible for a fine. Although the state tries to prevent it, unfortunately there are a certain number of drug addicts and dealers. We have been able to alleviate our usage of drugs to a point, yet we still suffer because of the over usage of narcotics. We hope for the guidance of more experienced countries and call upon the more developed. countries for financial contribution.
