**Topic: Stabilizing the distribution of medical assistance in Afghanistan's conflict post-pandemic**

Approximately half a million people in the Islamic Republic of Afghanistan are displaced and 18 to 18.5 million people in the Islamic Republic of Afghanistan are in need of aid. According to the UNHCR, 2.6 million Afghan refugees are registered, and 3.5 million are displaced around the world due to the Afghan Civil War. Nearby countries have been trying to handle the sudden influx of refugees from the Islamic Republic of Afghanistan. And for the upcoming seasons, the Turkish Red Crescent aims to run a long-term program which will decrease the number of displaced people in the Islamic Republic of Afghanistan and encourage immigrated Afghan people all over the world to return to their homelands by providing them with several funds. For example, during the war in Afghanistan, the Turkish Red Crescent has made lots of humanitarian aid to the Afghan people. With these livelihood improvements, supported Afghan citizens managed to return their homelands and illegal immigration decreased from the country. However, because of several reasons, humanitarian aid cannot be fairly distributed all over the country.

A new authority was appointed to the head of Afghan Red Crescent Society after the Taliban had seized power in the country. With the cooperation of the new Afghan Red Crescent Society authority, Turkish Red Crescent manages to deliver its humanitarian aid to the Islamic Republic of Afghanistan without facing any problems. For example, in this way, the Turkish Red Crescent managed to deliver 3 tons of food supplies to 800 Afghan families in August and 4 tons of food supplies to another 800 Afghan families in September with the cooperation of the Afghan Red Crescent Society, including Turkish Red Crescent's latest convoy which carries 33 tons of food supplies from over Islamic Republic of Pakistan to the Islamic Republic of Afghanistan in order to deliver food for 16,000 the Islamic Republic of Afghanistan citizens living in different areas of the country.

The Turkish Red Crescent proposes to other countries to work with the Afghan Red Crescent Society in order to stabilize the distribution of humanitarian aid in Afghanistan. With the contributions of the International Red Cross and other Red Cross societies, everyone in the Islamic Republic of Afghanistan can procure humanitarian aid and immigrated Afghan people might get encouraged to return to their country. With these progresses, the Turkish Red Crescent can achieve its goals which will make the Islamic Republic of Afghanistan a more liveable country for the Afghan people.
