Israel and UAE said on August 13 they would normalise diplomatic relations in a deal brokered by US. Presedent Donald Trump. President Khalifa Bin Zayed Al Nahyan issued a decree abolishing a boycott law as part of "The UAE efforts to expand diplomatic and commercial cooperation with Israel leading to bilateral relations by stimulating economic growth and promoting technological innovation" the WAM agency said. Israeli foreign Minister Gabi Askhani said UAE had taken "an important step towards peace wich yield substantial economic and commartial achivements for both people strengthening the stability in reigon." Mentioned deal signed in 15 September 2020. After that Palestinians express anger and despair over UAE-Israel peace deal. After these events Emirati Ministry of foreign Affairs said: "We have never abandoned Palestinians." Eventually Palestine refused UAE's medical supports.
