## **Handbook for JCC: Crusades**

### **A. Flow of the Committee**

The committee will mostly follow through with semi-moderated caucuses where any topic at hand will be discussed upon freely by all the representatives, and unmoderated caucuses where committee directives may be written.

Personal directives can be written at any time, but by definition, will only allow personal action which is limited by your role and job in the government.

Any information not provided during the study guide, such as but not limited to military status and enemy locations should be attained during the committee with the use of either committee directives, or for some representatives, personal directives.

Directives should be clear, eligible and detailed enough to be able to fully reconstruct a plan upon reading. Maps will be provided and may be used to further explain a plan, such as the deployment of an army.

The Sultan has the last say in any and every action of the governing cabinet, thus all personal and committee directives must be recognized and approved by him.

### **B. Roles of the Titles**

- Divan-I İstifa is responsible for the financial affairs of the Sultanate and will be represented by its executive, the Müsevfi.
- Divan-I Arz provides logistic support and supplies for the army and will be represented by its executive, the Arız.

- Divan-I İnşâ is the governing cabinet responsible for the domestic and international correspondence of the Sultanate and will be represented by its executive, the Tuğrai.
- Divan-I İşraf deals with administration within the Sultanate and will be represented by its executive, the Müşrif.
- Divan-I Berîd are the spymasters of the governing cabinet, and are an important source of information. They will be represented by its executive, the Sâhib-i Berîd.
- Naib Commanders are a part of the Divan of Niyabet-I Saltanat, the innermost circle of the Sultan. These people are some of the most trusted commanders of the Sultan himself.
- Reisü'l-Bahr is the commander of naval forces.
- Divan-I Pervane is responsible for the management of the pseudo-feudal “tımar” system of the Sultanate and will be represented by its executive, the Pervaneci.
